Dental hygiene is more than clean teeth. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), poor gum health can worsen blood sugar control in people with diabetes. Preventive care such as brushing twice daily, flossing, limiting sugary foods, and getting regular check-ups is key to maintaining oral health and avoiding serious conditions.

OMC's Dental Hygienist, Kimberly Hoover states that "Dental cleanings are essential for maintaining good oral health and preventing serious dental problems as home brushing and flossing may not remove all the plaque and total build." Build-ups can lead to cavities, gum disease and other serious health issues. Professional cleanings remove this hardened build-up to screen for conditions like oral cancer and identify potential problems and maintain overall and systemic health.
