Children ages 18 and younger may qualify for the State's "Vaccines For Children" Program which provides vaccines at no cost. At OMC, eligible youth can receive school-required vaccines for Hepatitis A and B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella, Rotavirus, TDAP, IPV, Meningococcal and more.

In order to qualify, children must be either enrolled in or eligible for Medicaid, or not be insured for a vaccination, or be an American Indian/Alaskan Native.
