

OMC BOARD CELEBRATES ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2023

On December 19, 2023, The Outpatient Medical Center Board of Directors held their final board meeting of 2023. During the meeting, the Board reviewed many accomplishments made towards its two-year strategic health plan. The Board and OMC staff members are committed to excellence in healthcare, patient service, and compliance with Federally Qualified Health Center regulations.

An FQHC is a nonprofit organization that receives federal funding to serve medically underserved areas and populations. OMC offers a Sliding Fee Discount Program that allows low-income patients to request an application for discounted services. Discounts may range from 20% to 100% of full charges. A patient who qualifies for a 100% discount (at 200% federal poverty level) is never refused services due to the inability to pay. The Sliding Fee program is unique to FQHCs and allows OMC to serve the underserved and those who are unable to seek care elsewhere.

OMC appreciates its patients as well as the Natchitoches, Leesville, and Tallulah communities that support its operations and its mission to help those with greatest need.

Outpatient Medical Center welcomes anyone to come to its clinic for services, regardless of income or insurance status.
