OMC's scope of service is routine general and family medicine. We are equipped to care for common chronic conditions like diabetes, hypertension, and elevated lipids, etc. We may also be able to assist with wellness visits, cancer screening, and many other common acute illnesses.

It OMC's clinical policy, and good medical practice, that any chronically-used controlled drugs and specialty medications be evaluated/prescribed by an appropriate specialist. This includes medications for ADHD and other psychiatric medications that require monitoring by a psychiatrist. Controlled drugs, including certain pain meds, may only be prescribed one-time for an acute injury, if the provider determines it is clinical necessary.

As always, we are happy to have you register and make an appointment for a provider to assess your needs (take a history and physical), so that we can make a referral for you to an appropriate medical specialist or pain management specialist. Only the specialist that we refer to can consider prescribing what you may be requesting.

If you have an urgent or emergency issue, you must seek care at the nearest urgent care clinic or emergency room.
